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MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF STUDIES MEETING HELD ON 18-12-2023 AT 10. 30 AM

The Board of Studies meeting for B.Sc., Computer Science (Semesters 2 to 6) and MCA (Semesters 2 to 4) was held on 18th December 2023 at 10.30 AM. The Board members Dr. K. Mani, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Computer Science, Nehru Memorial College (Autonomous), Puthanampatti, Tiruchirappalli (University Representative), Mr. M. P. Tony Reagan, Systech Software & Networking Academy (P) Ltd, Tiruchirappalli (Industry Expert) and all the staff members of the Department of Computer Science (both Shift I & Shift II) were present except Dr. C. Balakrishnan, Associate Professor, Department of Computer Science, CHRIST (Deemed to be University), Yeshwanthpur Campus, Nagasandra, Near Tumkur Road, Bengaluru-5600073 (Subject Expert-sent suggestions and observations for the BoS meeting) and Rev. Dr. S. Santiago SJ (who is on CL).

The meeting started with a silent prayer. Mr. A. Charles, Head of the department welcomed the external experts as well as the department staff members for the Board of Studies Meeting and requested the house to participate in the discussion. Head of the Department presented the B.Sc., Computer Science (Semesters 2 to 6) and MCA (Semesters 2 to 4) course pattern and Syllabi. The Head of the department also shared the suggestions given by Dr. C. Balakrishnan, Subject expert.

The University Representative Dr. K. Mani shared the following general observations:

- The total number of credits should be 120 for MCA and 140 for B.Sc.
- The teaching hours and credits for core courses should be uniform in all core courses.
- Three Discipline Specific Elective courses may be offered instead of two.
- ISBN number for the books may be included for all the books.


The University Representative Dr. K. Mani also shared the following suggestions in B.Sc and MCA Syllabi:

Suggestions by Board Members:

- Dr. H. Karamath Ali commended the well-planned and organized syllabi, acknowledging its coverage of all essential topics for Data Science professionals

- Dr. P. Anandkumar expressed the view that the revised syllabus demonstrates greater industry relevance and is better aligned for placement readiness compared to the previous 2021 M.Sc (Data Science) Syllabus. He proposed considering the MEAN stack course [Course Code: 23PDS2SP01] as a Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) rather than a self-paced learning course, and recommended the inclusion of a small project related to the same.
- Ms. Rajamallika suggested incorporating models creation using classes and objects in the Python Programming –Lab [Course Code: 23PDS2CP01], such as a simple game, simulations of real-world scenarios, or a basic data structure implementation.
- Mr.Saravanan proposed providing knowledge on SQLite3 along with Python programming in Semester 2 itself and incorporating the Dask/Dask-ML module and Streamlit to handle larger datasets and he also recommended pursuing Data science certifications from AWS, Microsoft Azure, IBM etc. and highlighting the same in students' resumes
- He acknowledged significant enhancements to the syllabus


A detailed discussion was held through the digital presentation. Each and every course was discussed and finalized with the course pattern. The table pertaining to the additions and deletions
