St Joseph's only college in TN to get special heritage status

Trichy: St Joseph's Autonomous College in Trichy is set to receive a special grant from the University Grants Commission (UGC) under the Special Heritage Status, the only college in the state to be recommended for the fund in the current year. A grant of Rs 1.67 crore will be provided to the college to maintain the heritage structures in the institution

The college was established in 1844 by the Fathers of Society of Jesus. In 1869, it was affiliated to the Madras University. The college celebrated its centenary in 1944 and sesquicentenary in 1995 and was awarded the Five-Star status by NAAC in 2000. The UGC recognised it as a College with Potential for Excellence (CPE) in 2004. In 2006, the college was reaccredited with A+

Grade by NAAC.

The College is owned by the Society of St.Joseph's, a body registered under Societies Regulation Act (1860) in Trichy.

Reverend Dr Andrew Francis SJ, principal, said with the grant from UGC, the college would renovate two old structures. The existing museum and herbarium building will be extended, he said.

The principal said funds have also been allocated for a six-month certificate course, one-year diploma course and a research survey where students will study the heritage structures that exist in the city in detail.

According to a list released by the UGC, a total of 19 colleges in the country have been selected under the scheme. The five colleges from the state that sent proposals got rejected except for the 171-year-old institution here


