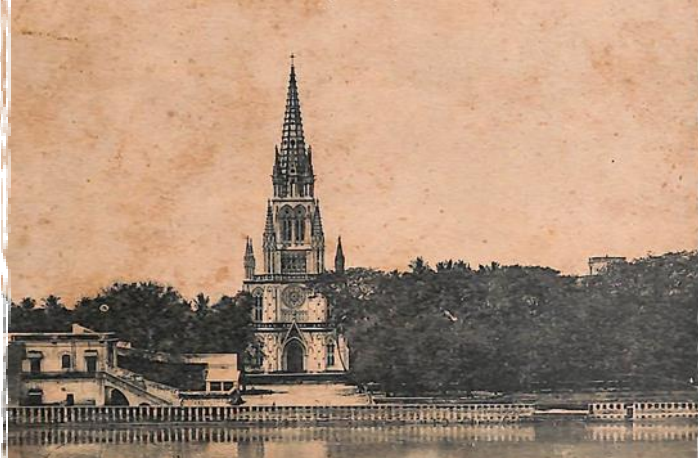

St Joseph's College bags NAAC's A++ grade

1st Autonomous Clg In Country To Achieve Top Grade: Principal

Trichy: St Joseph's College has become the first autonomous arts and science college in the country to secure the prestigious A++ rank for the fourth year of accreditation, according to college principal Rev Dr M Arockiasamy Xavier.

He said that the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) has rated the institution A++ with a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 3.56 out of 4 in the new format with 70% quantitative and 30% qualitative metrics.

Addressing reporters here on Tuesday, he expressed happiness at the feat saying it has added one more glorious feather to the institution at a time when its 175th year celebrations are on. The principal said that the institution enjoys the privilege of being the only college with 'special heritage' status from the University Grants Com-

mission in Tamil Nadu. "We applied for the IV cycle of NAAC accreditation process in March after 7 years. The peer team headed by 'Vice-Chancellor' of Omania University Hyderabad, Professor Ramachandran Sridhar, visited the college on June 27 and 28 for assessment of its human, infrastructural and financial resources besides its yeoman service to the progress of the society and the nation," Dr Arockiasamy said. The achievement will help the students of the college to get due recognition from institutions when they go for higher studies.

The Rajagopal Maharajan and Centre for Molecular Spectroscopy (CMS) and the adjoining National Natural History Museum will be among the direct beneficiaries of the herbarium studies and research support established to St. Joseph's College in Tiruchirappalli by the University Grants Commission (UGC).

"This building is not really reflective of Indian architecture," says Dr. K. S. Srinivasan, director, NHTT. But the NHTT is actually a museum of modern architecture, and houses, said a senior official, a lot of modern buildings next to our heritage sites, they are well known to the world."

The herbarium and natural history museum are housed in a 150-year-old building that has earlier been used as a school. NHTT has been acknowledged as a centre of excellence in the area of herbarium studies, said Dr. Srinivasan.

Digitisation of the herbarium's classical botanical records is among the main recent projects undertaken by NHTT. As many as 25,000 samples of plants had been scanned and classified according to genus and species since the project was started last year.

Once complete, "any researcher can access our records through our website, so it can become a resource centre that can be used worldwide," said Dr. Srinivasan. Some 30 computers have been dedicated to the task.

Simultaneously, NHTT has started a study to use DNA molecules to identify the plants, with the help of additional funds will help in this. The study will also help in identifying the plants, said Dr. Srinivasan.

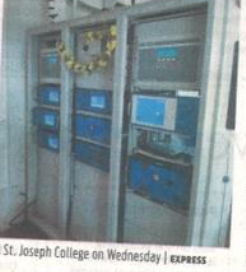

The systems installed will monitor air quality and share the data with Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board (TNPCB). Though TNPCB installed the system in St Joseph College in January last, the inauguration was delayed.

The project is the brainchild of former Chief Minister Jayalalithaa who, in 2015, announced that air quality monitoring systems would be installed in 28 places across the State.
