**Research Grant (SJCRG 2022-2023)**  
**(Institutional Seed Money for Research)**

The management of St. Joseph's College is keen to enhance and strengthen quality research among the staff, the scholars and the P.G. Students of St. Joseph's College. In this regard, the management has decided to provide research grant in the form of seed money to the staff and research assistance to PhD Scholars and P.G. Students.

**Objectives**

- ❖ To promote research ambience among the staff, the scholars and the PG students.
- ❖ To achieve quality, original, innovative and socially relevant research publications in reputed journals.
- ❖ To inculcate research thrust among the staff, the scholars and the students.
- ❖ To encourage the faculty and research scholars to apply for Research Grants and file patents.

**Details of Research Grant**

- ❖ Seed money for faculty up to Rs. 50,000.
- ❖ Research assistance for PhD Scholars (Full Time) up to Rs. 25,000.
- ❖ Project assistance for P.G. Students up to Rs. 15,000.
- ❖ Only half of the amount will be released initially and the remaining amount will be sanctioned after evaluating the progress.

**Guidelines**

- ❖ Interested faculty members (both Shift I &II), PhD Scholars and I P.G. Students are asked to submit the proposal along with their curriculum vitae in the given format (can be downloaded from the **RESEARCH** tab of the college website) and present the same on request.
- ❖ Period of Research – one year.
- ❖ Faculty members should possess proven research record.
- ❖ Maximum age limit for faculty to apply for the research grant is up to 50 years and should have completed at least 3 years of teaching at SJC.

- ❖ Proposal from PhD scholars and I P.G. students should be recommended by their respective guides.
- ❖ **The soft copy of the application should reach the Principal on or before 5th March 2022 ([college@mail.sjctni.edu](mailto:college@mail.sjctni.edu)) and the hard copy of the same has to reach the Dean of Research.**

### **Expected Outcome**


- ❖ The staff members are expected to publish at least one research article at the end of the proposed period in Scopus Index Journals, Web of Sciences, SCI Journals, etc. and should have applied for one funded project.
- ❖ Ph. D. Scholars are expected to publish one article in Scopus Index Journals, Web of Sciences, SCI Journals, etc. and another in UGC-Care listed journal.

OR

Two articles in UGC-Care listed journal.

- ❖ P. G. Students are expected to publish a minimum of two articles in any peer-reviewed journal with ISSN number.
- ❖ The SJC Research Assistance awardees are expected to continue their research in future and to mobilize sponsored research grant.

**Note:** Only I P.G. Students can apply for the grant and not II P.G.  
Only full-time Ph. D. Scholars who have completed first DC can apply.  
Those who have already availed themselves the SJCRG are asked not to apply for the grant.
